Situated at Walkers Flat on the River Murray, the Ankara campsite is 110 kms or about 1½ hours travelling time from Adelaide city.

The Ankara campsite offers uninterrupted access to the River Murray with breathtaking views of limestone cliffs. The general ambience of Ankara sets the tone for a great camping experience. Ankara offers a safe swimming area with all students required to wear buoyancy vests. The campsite has adjacent wetlands with a huge shallow lagoon for tailored aquatics, ponding, fishing and yabbying activities.
