Woodhouse is located in the stunning Piccadilly Valley in the Adelaide Hills, just 25 minutes from the GPO. Woodhouse offers 50 hectares of rolling hills, forest and creek environments for students to explore. The campsite has three separate accommodation centres.

A highlight of Woodhouse is the aptly named Challenge Hill obstacle course. Other attractions are the nearby Mount Lofty Botanic Gardens and Heysen Trail.

Woodhouse accommodation includes:

The Old House – 60 people

- Heritage accommodation for 60
- Leaders rooms

The Bunkhouse – 50 people

- Bunkhouse accommodation for 50
- Disabled access to ablutions
- Activities rooms

The Rymill Centre – 80 people

- High quality accommodation for 80 in 14 separate rooms
- Each room adjacent to double ensuite ablutions
- Air conditioned
- Private courtyard



Group Development

This program consists of a series of challenging and fun activities designed to improve group skills, develop initiative and enhance the students problem solving abilities.

Challenge Hill
