New Programs



Tribal Challenge (Years 6+)

A day program in which groups compete in a series of challenges. This program is based loosely on the hit TV show survivor.

Bush Survival Skills (Years 7+)

An orienteering course that takes a twist as students learn some bush survival skills (Navigation, Search & rescue, First aid, problem Solving & fire lighting)

Environmental Studies

This program helps students explore their natural environment and their role in its preservation and rehabilitation in practical and fun ways.

Ponding & Water Testing- Investigate water quality and examine the impact of humans in water catchments.

River Studies & Water Users Game

The Amazing Earthworm.....students will work in pairs construct a desk-top worm farm to take back to school or home.

Animals & Their Environments – A unique way of looking at how animals adapt to their environment.



Aboriginal Studies

This program introduces students to the traditional skills and unique culture of Indigenous Australian people, providing hands-on experiences they will always remember.
