EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

OUT DOOR FIRE - OUTBREAK OF FIRE / SMOKE IN YOUR VICINITY

- 1. Remain inside
- 2. Turn on Reticulation
- 3. Evacuation directed by Emergency Services
- Call Emergency Services as directed by school administrators:

5. Do not re-enter the area until advised by the Caretaker or Fire Service

INTERNAL FIRE - OUTBREAK OF FIRE / SMOKE IN YOUR VICINITY

- 1. Stay calm & reassure campers
- 2. Ensure the immediate safety of anyone within the vicinity of the fire
- 3. **Evacuate** immediately, as per evacuation procedures to rotunda
- 4. Mark rolls
- 5. Call Emergency Services as directed by school administrators:

Metropolitan Fire Service Ph 000

Police Ph 000 Ambulance Ph 000

6. Do not re-enter the area until advised by the Caretaker or Fire Service

SEVERE STORM - FIRST WARNING RESPONSE

- Terminate all outdoor activities and return indoors
- If the storm is electrical disconnect all electrical appliances
- 1. When the storm strikes:
- Ensure everybody stays away from windows
- If an electrical storm DO NOT USE THE TELEPHONE
- 2. After the storm passes:
- Check the buildings for damage
- Check outside for fallen power lines, trees and debris

EVACUATION PROCEDURES - Upon continuous ringing of camp bell

- 1. Follow the Ankara Evacuation Plan posted in each room each plan indicates the route to the Evacuation Assembly Area - Rotunda
- 2. Avoid smoke filled areas if you must use a smoke filled exit, crouch low
- 3. All windows and doors must be closed for fires if a bomb threat has been made then all doors and windows must be left open
- 4. If using machinery or hazardous materials when the alarm sounds, the following procedure should be followed:
- switch off Machinery
- close Valves to Gas supplies •
- switch off Electricity Pumps & Air Conditioners •
- 5. All campers are to exit to Rotunda and assemble there for roll call
- 6. The Camp Group Leader will mark Rolls and report any absences to the Caretaker
- 7. APPOINT GROUP LEADERS TO CHECK AREAS OF CAMPSITE:
- Female Leaders female end
- Male Leaders male end
- Cooks Dining Rm/Kitchen/Washroom
- Hall, River, Roadside
- 8. All actions taken by campers will be directed by the Caretaker/Camp Group Leader
- 9. All people evacuated remain at Rotunda until the all-clear announcement has been made by the outdoor educatio Caretaker/Camp Group Leader.
